

Air Liquide strengthens its presence in Northern Germany to meet increasing demand

Air Liquide will increase its liquid production and storage capacity at its Hamburg site in Northern Germany. This investment of approximately 25 millions euros will enable Air Liquide to meet the liquid nitrogen needs of its customers in the region, particularly those in the manufacturing, production, food and pharma industries.

In the context of a long term [contract renewal in July 2024 with Aurubis](#), Air Liquide has decided to significantly expand its production capabilities in Hamburg, Northern Germany, even further. With four existing air separation units in Hamburg which are currently being modernized, Air Liquide has decided to install a new liquefier to increase and optimize its liquid production and logistics fleet to meet market demand and growth opportunities.

Air Liquide aims to support its customers in their development projects. This investment will enable the company to serve the growing market in northern Germany as well as the Netherlands and Southern Denmark. In these regions, Air Liquide Germany serves customers in diverse sectors such as food and beverage, chemicals, metal fabrication, pharmaceuticals, research, etc.

Bringing our product closer to customers, this project will result in improved reliability, reduced carbon footprint while enhancing ability to meet the growing needs. It will also provide additional flexibility to meet clients' demand in answer to their seasonal peaks in activity.
